

1) Should Falls Church City increase the percentage of affordable housing set-asides to 10% or higher?

???. I believe we need to use a lot of tools to make Falls Church City affordable, and set-asides is one of those tools. Reducing zoning restrictions is another. Housing and transportation are the two biggest items in most family budgets, and one way to make Falls Church City affordable is to reduce transportation costs through robust public transit.
